IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. AD-220r be and it is hereby granted and Grace Community Bible Church, North Platte, Nebraska be and is hereby authorized to connect an automatic dialingannouncing device in accordance with its application, Rules Nebraska Statutes and the Requlations and this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be and it is hereby made the Commission's official registration as hereinbefore set forth and shall remain in force and effect for two years from this date unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, upon receipt of this order and prior to connecting the device to any telephone line, the applicant shall notify the serving telephone company in writing of its intent to connect or operate such device and identify the line to which connection is proposed.
