O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

By application filed on February 12, 1996, JC Penney Co., Inc., Omaha, Nebraska, seeks authority to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device. This application is a renewal from AD-200r.

Applicant proposes to connect a Microlog Corp. VCS2100 A9091978 automatic dialing-announcing device.

Applicant advises this Commission that the device will not be used for advertising purposes and has stated that messages being transmitted will inform their customers that catalog orders have arrived.

Having reviewed the matter, the Commission finds that the application does comply with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission regarding the registration of automatic dialing-announcing devices.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. AD-222r be and it is hereby granted and JC Penney Co., Inc., Omaha, Nebraska be and it is hereby authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in accordance with its application, the Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be and it is hereby made the Commission's official registration as hereinbefore set forth and shall remain in force and effect for two years from this date unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, upon receipt of this order and prior to connecting the device to any telephone line, the applicant shall notify the serving telephone company in writing of its intent to connect or operate such device and identify the line to which connection is proposed.


