By application filed on January 29, 1998, US West Communications, Inc., Denver, Colorado, seeks authority to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device.

Applicant proposes to connect a Dialogic D/160 SC-LS Processing Boards automatic dialing-announcing device.

Applicant advises this Commission that the device will not automatically be used for advertising purposes; however, it will be used to inform US West customers that changes, additions or deletions to their phone service have been completed as requested. Applicant submitted a written transcript of the message being transmitted, along with a six-page diagram of the information available when contacted by the device.

Having reviewed the matter, the Commission finds that the application does comply with the applicable statutes and rules and regulations of the Commission regarding the registration of automatic dialing-announcing devices.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. AD-237r be, and it is hereby, granted and US West Communications, Inc. be, and it is hereby, authorized to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in accordance with its application, the Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby, made the Commission's official registration as hereinbefore set forth and shall remain in force and effect for two years from this date unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, upon receipt of this order and prior to connecting the device to any telephone line, the applicant shall notify the serving telephone company in writing of its intent to connect or operate such device and identify the line to which connection is proposed.



