IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, upon receipt of this order and prior to connecting the device to any telephone line, the Applicant shall notify the serving telephone company in writing of its intent to connect or operate such device and identify the line to which connection is proposed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant notify the Commission of any changes in the information contained in its application within five days and script changes within twenty-four hours.
