Applicant is a corporation located in the State of Nebraska, whose mailing address is 941 O Street, Suite 920, Lincoln, NE 68508. Applicant proposes to use a Proprietary software web based service manufactured by CallFire to connect an automatic dialing-announcing device in Lincoln, Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be, and it is hereby, made the Commission's official registration as set forth in this order and shall remain in force and effect for two years from this date unless used in a manner inconsistent with state or federal law.
