By application filed on August 1, 2017, Gravis Marketing, Inc. (Applicant), of Winter Springs, Florida, seeks authority to register and connect an automatic dialing-announcing device located in Reston, Virginia.

Applicant is a Florida corporation whose mailing address is 910 Belle Avenue, #1180, Winter Springs, Florida 32708. Applicant proposes to use an Asterisk Phone System model version 14 dialing-announcing device.

Having reviewed the matter, the Commission finds that the application complies with the applicable statutes and Rules and Regulations of the Commission regarding automatic dialing-announcing devices.
