By application filed on November 27, 2017, Array Services Group, Inc., (Applicant), Sartell, Minnesota, seeks authority to register the connection of an automatic dialing-announcing device located at 200 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue East, Sartell, Minnesota, to a telephone line.
