OPINION AND FINDINGS

On July 28, 2015, the Communications Department (Department) Director filed a Complaint against Victory Enterprises, Inc., (Respondent) seeking to fine Respondent on the grounds that it failed to timely file its Automatic Dialing-Announcing Device (ADAD) script as prescribed by Neb.
