O P I N I O N     A N D     F I N D I N G S

On July 28, 2015, the Communications Department (Department) Director filed a complaint against Gravis Marketing, Inc., (Respondent) seeking to fine Respondent on the grounds that it failed to validly register its automatic dialing-announcing device (ADAD) prior to transmitting messages in Nebraska through its ADAD in violation of *Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-256*.

Respondent and the Department Director have entered into a stipulation resolving the allegations and the Respondent has paid its fine. Upon review of the stipulation, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that it should be approved and the Complaint should be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the stipulation between Gravis Marketing, Inc., and the Department be, and is hereby, approved and the above-captioned complaint is dismissed.
