O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On May 10, 2016, the Telecommunications Department (Department) Director filed a Complaint against TCN, Inc., (Respondent) seeking to fine Respondent on the grounds that it failed to timely file its Automatic Dialing-Announcing Device (ADAD) script as prescribed by Neb. Rev. Stat. § 86-256(5).

On May 23, 2016, Respondent provided documentation that the script in question was filed in a timely manner and therefore the above-captioned complaint was opened against the Respondent in error. The Department recommends the complaint be dismissed. Upon review the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the Department recommendation should be approved and the Complaint should be dismissed as no violation of the ADAD Act occurred.
