OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed April 21, 1980, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, seeks approval of a revision of the service area of its Bertrand telephone exchange.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

A copy of the proposed service area map No. 5 for the Bertrand exchange is attached to the application and made a part hereof by reference.

Applicant proposes to revise its Bertrand service area to serve Michael Dawson now located in unserved territory between Bertrand and the Edison exchange of Northwestern Bell Telephone Company.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-7 be and it is hereby granted, and the General Telephone Company of the Midwest be and it is hereby authorized to revise its Bertrand service area as set forth in the map referred to in the Opinion and Findings, which by this reference is made a part hereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an appropriate service area map with the Commission.
