OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed May 9, 1980, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks approval of a revision of the service area of its Broken Bow telephone exchange.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

A copy of the proposed service area map No. 10 for the Broken Bow exchange is attached to the application and made a part hereof by reference.

Applicant proposes to revise its Broken Bow service area to serve Ron Cole and Hugh Clarke, now located in the Ansley exchange of Nebraska Central Telephone Company.

Affidavits have been received indicating that the application is agreeable to all parties and that no duplication of facilities will be created.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. Cl4 be and it is hereby granted, and the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to revise its Broken Bow service area as set forth in the map referred to in the Opinion and Findings, which by this reference is made a part hereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant and Nebraska Central Telephone Company file appropriate service area maps with the Commission.
