OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed May 16, 1980, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, seeks authority to offer Universal Data Jacks and clarify text on jacks for portable telephones.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference are copies of the following proposed tariff sheets:

Second Revised Sheet 6A, Section II

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to offer two new jacks for use with data equipment at installation charges of \$34.00 and \$36.00 and to revise the text of its tariff relating to Jack and Plug Equipment.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-16 be and it is hereby granted and the General Telephone Company of the Midwest be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.
