OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed May 22, 1980, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks approval of revised Zone Boundary and Base Rate Area Maps for Grand Island, Nebraska.

Notice of the the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant proposes to enlarge the Grand Island Base Rates Area on the east and west. In addition, the Zone A boundary will be extended approximately one mile. The proposed change will result in reductions in rates for 926 subscribers.

Upon consideration of this application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-18 be and it is hereby granted and the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to revise its Local Exchange Tariff and Zone boundary map as set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that applicant file an appropriate tariff sheet with with the Commission.
