OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed May 27, 1980, The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, Lincoln, Nebraska, seeks authority to revise the General Exchange Tariff to provide for the SX-100 and 200 digital switching systems and revise optional payment plans and 120 and 1200 series digital switching systems.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to offer SX-100 and 200 Digital Switching Systems having capacities of 112 and 208 lines or trunks, respectively. It is also proposed to offer 1200 Series Digital Switching System magnetic recording units, provide for modifying GTD 120 Digital Switching Systems and revise Optional Payment Plans to provide for deferred service charge payments.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-20 be and it is hereby granted and The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission.
