OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed June 12, 1980, Mid-State Systems, Inc., McCook, Nebraska seek approval of tariff and rates.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of applicant's proposed tariff consisting of 19 pages. The proposed tariff contains definitions, regulations and rates applying to two-way and one-way domestic public land mobile radio service through applicant's base station at Imperial, Nebraska, and is similar to tariffs which have been approved for other radio common carriers, and for applicant's McCook, Nebraska base station.

Applicant's proposed rates include the following:

One-way:

Registry and unlimited calls	
Tone and voice	\$15.00
Land line telephone number	.80
Equipment rental and maintenance	
Tone and voice paging unit	12.50

Two-way:

Mobile and portable	
Registry and Unlimited 3 minute calls	25.00
Each message unit	.10
Equipment rental and maintenance	
Portable	35.00
Deluxe mobile	50.00

In addition, daily and transient service will be provided.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-26 be and it is hereby granted and Mid-State Systems, Inc. be and it is hereby authorized to charge and collect the rates and charges set forth in the tariff referred to in the Opinion and Findings herein.
