OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed June 13, 1980, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks authority to waive a non-recurring charge for 30 days.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant proposes to conduct a promotional program to stimulate the sale of Custom Calling Services at its exchanges from July 13, 1980 to August 13, 1980 and request authority to waive and suspend the authorized service ordering charge for Custom Calling Services installed during this period.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.
