OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed June 16, 1980, Charles P. Oden, d/b/a Nebraska Radio Telephone Systems, Grand Island, Nebraska, seeks approval of its tariff covering mobile telephone and radio paging service in Lincoln, Nebraska.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of applicant's tariff consisting of 19 pages of regulations and rates governing mobile telephone and radio paging service furnished at its base station in Lincoln, Nebraska.

A review of the proposed tariff indicates that it generally conforms to the tariffs of other radio common carriers approved by the Commission.

Basic monthly rates proposed are:

Applicant's proposed tariff has shown rates separately for rental and maintenance of company provided equipment. These rates should be combined into one rate covering both rental and maintenance.

Applicant has also proposed to apply a delinquency charge of 1-1/2% per month on all subscriber accounts with balances in arrears. This provision should be deleted from the tariff.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that, as modified above, the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted in part.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-29 be and it is hereby granted in part and Charles P. Oden, d/b/a Nebraska Radio Telephone Systems be and it is hereby authorized to establish tariffs for Lincoln, Nebraska, as set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that rates for rental and maintenance of company provided equipment be combined.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the proposed charge of 1-1/2% per month for delinquent accounts be and it is hereby denied.
