## OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed June 19, 1980, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks approval of revisions of the service areas of its Mason City and Litchfield telephone exchanges.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Copies of the proposed service area maps for the Mason City and Litchfield exchanges are attached to the application and made a part hereof by reference.

Applicant proposes to revise its Mason City and Litchfield service areas to provide Mason City service to Robert Hawkins who is now located in unserved territory between Mason City and the Miller exchange of General Telephone Company of the Midwest. The Litchfield service area is being revised to eliminate unserved territory between applicant's Litchfield and Mason City exchanges.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-33 be and it is hereby granted, and the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to revise its Mason City and LitCofield service areas as set forth in the maps referred to in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate service area maps with the Commission.
