OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed June 19, 1980, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks approval of tariff sheets of its General Exchange Tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff covering Electronic Switching Systems Exchange Service to offer new optional items including Tandem Tie Lines Capability, Attendant Camp-On, Attendant Call Thru Test on Tie Lines and Advanced Private Line Terminations.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.
