OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By order entered April 21, 1981, in the above-captioned application, the Commission authorized Southeast Nebraska Telephone Company to increase rates in an amount to produce additional annual revenue of \$60,492.00.

On May 14, 1981, applicant filed with the Commission for approval of a schedule of rates and charges designed to produce the additional revenue allowed.

Applicant's proposed rates and charges are set forth below:

	Proposed Rate
Business 1 party	\$28.00
Residence 1 party	11.00
Residence 2 party	10.25
Residence 4 party rural	10.00

The Commission has examined applicant's proposed rate schedule and finds that it conforms to the order of April 21, 1981.

Premises considered, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the schedule of rates and charges for telephone service set forth herein are fair and reasonable, are in the public interest and should be approved to become effective on the first billing date following the date of this order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission pursuant to the order entered April 21, 1981, in Application No. C-35 that applicant be and it is hereby authorized to charge and collect the rates and charges set for in the Opinion and Findings herein, effective on the first billing date following the date of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate revised tariff sheets with the Commission.
