OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed July 2, 1980, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks approval of a tariff sheet of its Local Exchange Tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the following proposed tariff sheet:

Ninth Revised Sheet 18, Local Exchange Tariff.

Applicant seeks to revise its Local Exchange Tariff to reflect the offering of improved rural service to Nebraska customers of the authorized Hamburg, Iowa exchange. One and two party rates as authority by the Iowa Public Service Commission will apply for service from the Hamburg exchange. Multi party service will be discontinued on December 31, 1980.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-38 be and it is hereby granted and the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.
