OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed July 9, 1980, The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company, Lincoln, Nebraska, seeks approval of a revision of the service area of its Hastings telephone exchange.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

A copy of the proposed service area map for the Hastings exchange is attached to the application and made a part hereof by reference.

Applicant proposes to revise its Hastings, Nebraska service area to serve John R. Keogh, now located in the Trumbull exchange of Hamilton Telephone Company.

Affidavits have been received indicating that the application is agreeable to all parties and that no duplication of facilities will be created.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.
