By its application filed July 11, 1980, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks approval of a tariff sheet of its General Exchange Tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is copy of the following proposed tariff sheet:

Sixth Revised Sheet 16A, Section 11, General Exchange Tariff.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to increase the monthly rate on its 4A Speakerphone from \$8.00 to \$11.25 and the installation charge from \$20.00 to \$25.00. It is also proposed to offer a new 80 Type Control Unit as an option which will enable the customer to use the Speakerphone on either exchange or private line service.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.
