OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed July 14, 1980, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks the modification of the Commission's order in Docket C-27.

Notice of the filing of this application was published pursuant to the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

By Commission order entered July 1, 1980 in Docket C-27, applicant was authorized to waive the Service Ordering Charge in connection with Custom Calling Service.

Applicant now seeks to extend the period during which such charges are waived until September 26, 1980.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that application C-46 be and it is hereby granted and the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to waive the Service Ordering Charge for Custom Calling Service until September 26, 1980.
