#### BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed July 17, 1980, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks approval of tariff sheets of its General Exchange Tariff.

Applicant proposes to establish increase Vintage II pricing for the Dimension 2000 PBX, which reflect current costs of providing the service. The annual increase in revenue will be approximately \$9,700. It is also proposed to offer a new Expanded Memory Control Carrier, Ringing and Interrupter Unit and non-recurring charges for Automatic Route Selection design recommendations.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

### ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-48 be and it is hereby granted and the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.
