Applicant proposes to establish increase Vintage II pricing for the Dimension 2000 PBX, which refect current costs of providing the service. The annual increase in revenue will be approximately \$9,700. It is also proposed to offer a new Expanded Memory Control Carrier, Ringing and Interupter Unit and non-recurring charges for Automatic Route Selection design recommendations.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.
