OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed July 28, 1980, Central Radiophone Company, Gothenburg, Nebraska, seeks approval of tariff and rates.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of applicant's proposed tariff consisting of 18 pages. The proposed tariff contains definitions, regulations and rates applying to two-way and one-way domestic public land mobile radio service through applicant's base station at Cozad, Nebraska, and is similar to tariffs which have been approved for other radio common carriers.

Applicant's proposed rates include the following:

Tone only paging service	\$10.75
Tone and voice paging service	15.75
Telephone number assigned	1.00
Tone only pager rental	7.50
Tone and voice pager rental	14.00
Two-way mobile and portable service	15.75
Two-way IMTS mobile service	39.75
Each message unit	.25
Two-way mobile and portable rental	23.75
Two-way IMTS mobile rental	52.00

In addition, daily and transient service will be provided.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-51 be and it is hereby granted and Central Radiophone Company be and it is hereby authorized to charge and collect the rates and charges set forth in the tariff referred to in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file a copy of its tariff with the Commission.
