OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By order entered February 23, 1981, the Commission granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Mid-State Systems, Inc., McCook, Nebraska, to operate as a radio common carrier within a 35 mile radius of the intersections of Highways 25 and 25A in Hayes County, Nebraska.

The Commission's order further provided that the authority granted would expire in one year unless extended by the Commission.

On February 18, 1982, Mid-State Systems, Inc., notified the Commission that because of the sale of real estate it was unable to lease its proposed tower site and requested a one year extension of time.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that a one year extension of time should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that a one year extension of time be and it is hereby granted in Application No. C-56 for Mid-State Systems, Inc., to begin the operations authorized.
