## OPINION AND FINDINGS

## BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed August 6, 1980, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks approval of a tariff sheet of its General Exchange Tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the following proposed tariff sheet:

Original Sheet 13, Seciton 18, General Exchange Tariff.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to offer a new service known as Dial-It Service. This service consists of pre-recorded announcements which can be accessed by dialing an assigned telephone number. Initially the service will consist of sports, weather and a Christmas story and will be available on a local call basis within the Omaha, Nebraska calling area at a charge of 20¢ per call. Calls made from coin phones would be charged the coin rate in addition to the 20¢; long distance callers would be charged the appropriate toll charge in lieu of the 20¢.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-57 be and it is hereby granted and the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an appropriate tariff sheet with the Commission.
