OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed September 18, 1980, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, seeks to restrict the offering of Direct Inward Dial PABX trunks and stations to only those exchanges where the central office is equipped to handle these services.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the following proposed tariff sheet.

Eighth Revised Sheet 29, Section II of the General Exchange Service Tariffs.

Applicant seeks to restrict the offering of Direct Inward Dial (DID) Trunks and Stations to only those exchanges where the central offices are equipped to handle this service to avoid having to add very costly additional facilities to a central office for provision of this service.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-74 be and it is hereby granted and the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission.
