OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed September 23, 1980, the Continental Telephone Company of Nebraska, Wisner, Nebraska, seeks authority to revise its Wood Lake and Wolbach Local Exchange Tariffs.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference are copies of the following proposed tariff sheets 27 and 28, Section 4 of applicants tariff.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff and rates at its Wolbach and Wood Lake exchange to reflect uniform private line rates for urban and rural subscribers. Present and proposed rates are:
