OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed October 1, 1980, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks approval of a tariff sheet of its General Exchange Tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the following proposed tariff sheet:

Applicant is proposing to introduce a Noise Canceling Head Telephone Set, a lightweight head telephone set designed for use by Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) air traffic controllers and other government customers in noisy environments. Charges would be \$11.50 monthly, a non-recurring charge of \$35.00 and customer would be subject to multi-element service connection charges.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-80 be and it is hereby granted and the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an appropriate tariff sheet with the Commission.
