By its application filed October 1, 1980 the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska seeks authority to add text to its General Rules and Regulations Tariffs regarding automatic dialing-announcing devices.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations One letter of protest to the application was filed.

The subject of automatic dialing-announcing devices is addressed in Chapter XI of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. On February 2, 1981 applicant submitted a letter withdrawing its application.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be dismissed at applicant's request.
