OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed October 16, 1980, the Hamilton Telephone Company, Aurora, Nebraska, seeks authority to amend its General Exchange Tariff to provide revised procedures and rate schedules regarding its telephone service and service connection charges.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference are copies of the proposed tariff sheets.

Applicant seeks to amend certain sheets of its General Exchange Tariff and to establish a revised procedure and rate schedule in the following areas:

- (1) to eliminate monthly charges for colored telephones and long cords
- (2) to provide for rate changes for additional styles of decorator phones and to delete those no longer offered by applicant
- (3) to revise service connection charges to eliminate the flat rate service charge and to initiate a multi-level service charge
- (4) to provide in its rate schedule for the inclusion of additional type of Electronic PABX equipment to replace switchboard and switching equipment
- (5) to increase of premise extension charge, and
- (6) to establish a credit of 50¢ per month and a maintenance of service charge for customer-owned equipment

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-88 be and it is hereby granted and the Hamilton Telephone Company, Aurora, Nebraska be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission.
