OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed October 24, 1980, Continental Telephone Company of Nebraska, Wisner, Nebraska, seeks modification of its tariff to increase service connection charges.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. Twelve letters of protest and a petition containing 123 signatures opposing the application were received.

On January 16, 1981, the Commission received a letter from applicant asking permission to withdraw its application.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be dismissed at applicant's request.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-93 be and it is hereby dismissed at applicant's request.
