OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By joint application filed November 14, 1980, Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska and Keystone-Arthur Telephone Company, Keystone, Nebraska, seek acceptance and approval of revised service area maps of their adjoining Nebraska telephone exchanges.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Copies of proposed service area maps for the following exchanges are attached to the application and made a part hereof by reference:

Northwestern Bell Telephone Company

Keystone-Arthur Telephone Company

Ogallala

Keystone

Applicants propose to revise the service area boundaries between the above exchanges to eliminate unserved territory and achieve a common boundary. No subscriber's service will be affected by the proposed revisions.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-96 be and it is hereby granted and Northwestern Bell Telephone Company and Keystone-Arthur Telephone Company be and they are hereby authorized to revise their service area maps referred to in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicants file appropriate service area maps with the Commission.
