OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By order entered April 21, 1981, the Commission granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Central Radiophone Company, North Platte, Nebraska, to operate as a radio common carrier within a 35 mile radius of Ogallala, Nebraska.

The Commission's order further provided that the authority granted would expire in one year unless extended by the Commission.

On April 26, 1982, Central Radiophone Company, notified the Commission that because of equipment problems with Northwestern Bell Telephone Company it would be unable to provide interconnected service within the time allowed.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that a one year extension of time should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that a one year extension of time be and it is hereby granted in Application No. C-109, for Central Radiophone Company, to begin the operations authorized.
