OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed January 6, 1981, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks approval of a revision of the service area of its Alliance, Nebraska telephone exchange.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

A copy of the proposed service area map No. 13 for the Alliance exchange is attached to the application and made a part hereof by reference.

Applicant proposes to revise its Alliance service area to include unserved territory between Alliance and the Bingham exchange of Consolidated Telephone Company.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-115 be and it is hereby granted, and the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to revise its Alliance service area as set forth in the map referred to in the Opinion and Findings, which by this reference is made a part hereof.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file an appropriate service area map with the Commission.
