OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed February 17, 1981, the Nebraska Central Telephone Company, Gibbon, Nebraska seeks authority to adjust its rates and charges for telephone service.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Pursuant to notice required by law, public hearing was held on the application on July 20, 1981 at 9:30 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska, with appearances as set forth above.

In a separate order on this application the Commission authorized an increase in annual revenue of \$93,000.

Proposed rates, by rate groups are set forth on the attached Nebraska Central Telephone Company Tariffs filed with this Commission and incorporated herein by reference.

The Commission has examined the applicants proposed rate schedule and finds that it conforms to the order of September 22, 1981.

All premises considered, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the schedule of rates and charges for telephone service as set forth in the attached proposed tariffs are fair and reasonable, are in the public interest and should be granted to become effective November 1, 1981.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission pursuant to the original order entered in Application C-122 on September 22, 1981, that applicant be and it is hereby authorized to charge and collect the rates and charges as set forth in the tariff submitted and attached, all by reference made a part hereof, effective November 1, 1981.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with this Commission.
