OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed March 5, 1981, the Hamilton Telephone Company of Aurora, Nebraska, seeks approval of a revision of the service area of its Hampton telephone exchange.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

A copy of the proposed service area map for the Hampton exchange is attached to the application and made a part hereof by reference.

Applicant proposes to revise its Hampton service area to serve Harold E. Andreason now located in the Bradshaw exchange of The Lincoln Telephone and Telegraph Company.

Affidavits have been received indicating that the application is agreeable to all parties and that no duplication of facilities will be created.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER
