OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed March 11, 1981, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, seeks authority to offer dial call puckup displays.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference are copies of the following proposed tariff sheets:

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to offer Dial Call Pickup Displays which are used on single line telephones, within groups, to allow the user to answer other telephones in the group displayed on their telephone. They are for use with electronic PABX systems and are offered at both regular monthly rates and Two-Tier rates.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.
