OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed March 11, 1981, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, for authority to revise the service area maps of its Columbus and Duncan, Nebraska exchanges.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

This proposed change in service area is to permit applicant to serve two subscribers from its Columbus exchange rather than the Duncan exchange. Since both exchanges are owned and operated by the same company, no application to the Commission is necessary.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application should be dismissed.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-129 be and it is hereby dismissed.
