OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed March 17, 1981, the United Telephone Company of the West, Scottsbluff, Nebraska, seeks authority to remove ownership of directories paragraph.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference are copies of the following proposed tariff sheets:

General Rules and Regulations:
Second Revised Sheet 4
First Revised Sheet 5

Applicant's tariff presently provides that directories remain the property of the telephone company and must be returned when a new issue is delivered. Applicant now proposes to delete from its tariff the paragraph referring to ownership of directories.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-131 be and it is hereby granted and the United Telephone Company of the West be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file appropriate tariff sheets with the Commission.
