Applicant seeks to increase its rates for Telex Service, Teletypewriter Exchange Service and certain services ancillary to them. The rates being filed match those already on file with the Federal Communications Commission.

The new rates are projected to produce additional revenues in Nebraska of approximately \$16,721 which will improve the Company's return on its operation in Nebraska to 1.9 percent.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-134 be and it is hereby granted and the Western Union Telegraph Company, Upper Saddle River, New Jersey be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.
