OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed April 17, 1981, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks approval of a revision of the service area of its Ogallala telephone exchange.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

A copy of the proposed service area map No. 13 for the Ogallala exchange is attached to the application and made a part hereof by reference.

Applicant proposes to revise its Ogallala service area to serve Mr. Doug Jarosz now located in unserved territory between Ogallala and the Grant exchange of Central Nebraska Telephone Company.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-144 be and it is hereby granted, and the North-western Bell Telephone Company be and it is hereby authorized to revise its Ogallala service area as set forth in the map referred to in the Opinion and Findings, which by this reference is made a part hereof.
