OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 31, 1981 the Federal Communications Commission released its First Report and Order with respect to accounting for station connections. The FCC's order directs that costs of station connections be charged to expense accounts rather than to asset accounts.

Since this ruling will affect all telephone companies under the jurisdiction of this Commission, and their subscribers, the Commission will require that the telephone industry in the State of Nebraska appear at a hearing at 1:30 p.m., May 19, 1981 in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska regarding the impact of the expensing of station connections in the State of Nebraska.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that all telephone companies, or their representative, be and they are required to appear at a hearing at 1:30 p.m., May 19, 1981 in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska regarding the impact of the expensing of station connections in the State of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this order be sent to all telephone companies under the jurisdiction of this Commission.
