OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed April 29, 1981, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, seeks authority to discontinue two-party urban service in its Alma Exchange and urban residential four-party service in its Alma and Heartwell Exchanges.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference is a copy of the following proposed tariff sheet:

Section No. 1, Revision No. 25th, Sheet No. F

Applicant seeks to discontinue residential two-party and four-party urban service in its Alma exchange, and residential four-party urban service in the Heartwell exchange programs in these listed exchanges. All customers will be upgraded to one-party service.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-150 be and it is hereby granted and the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant file a appropriate tariff sheet with the Commission.
