OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed June 3, 1981, the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska, seeks approval of tariff sheets of its General Exchange Tariff.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Attached to the application and incorporated herein by reference are copies of the following proposed tariff sheets:

Original Sheets 1 thru 10, Section 44

Applicant seeks to offer the 80/5 Call Management System (CMS), a distributed microprocessor-controlled switching system which provides full automatic call distributor (ACD) and private branch exchange (PBX) features and is designed to serve customers who need a small to medium size ACD system integrated with a small PBX system.

Upon consideration of the application and attending circumstances and being fully advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that the application is fair and reasonable, is in the public interest and should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. C-154 be and it is hereby granted and the Northwestern Bell Telephone Company, Omaha, Nebraska be and it is hereby authorized to revise its tariff to include the sheets set forth in the Opinion and Findings herein.
