OPINION AND FINDINGS

BY THE COMMISSION:

By its application filed June 25, 1981, the General Telephone Company of the Midwest, Columbus, Nebraska, seeks authority to revise its General Exchange Service tariffs regarding Tier A payments for Dial Call Pickup Displays.

Notice of the filing of the application was published pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. No protest to the application was filed.

Applicant seeks to revise its tariff to establish a one time payment Tier A rate for Dial Call Pickup Displays. One time rates proposed are \$526.00 for 11 line units and \$783.00 for 24 line units. Regular Tier B monthly rates would also apply.
